



Up Next Recordings, James Lyng High School's student-run record label, returns with a second collection of music written and recorded by James Lyng students, entitled "Up Next Mixtape #2". The collection includes rap songs, instrumental hip hop and R&B tracks written and performed by students in W.O.R.D. (a hip hop literacy program at James Lyng), created in the school's student-centered music classes, as well as performances of cover songs by James Lyng's choir.

The mixtape is the second release from Up Next Recordings, a record label organized as a part of the school's entrepreneurship class. With this second mixtape, Up Next Recordings hit its stride with a strong and consistent collection of music.

The songs on the mixtape were recorded at James Lyng's own professional quality recording studio.
